Minutes of the Annual Church Conference January 21, 2024

Wilshire Baptist Church Dallas, Texas

The 2024 Annual Church Conference was held via Zoom and in person. Timothy Peoples, senior pastor, was moderator. Heather Mustain, associate pastor, monitored Zoom.

Welcome and Prayer by Paula Woodbury at 12:15 p.m.

- A lot has happened in the last 365 days. We have seen God move inside and outside these doors.
- Little details make the big work happen.
- We appreciate all who have worked on details so we can continue to do the good work.

Items of business:

Timothy Peoples, moderator, calls the meeting to order at 12:19 p.m.

I. Clerk's 2023 Report

- 1. Timothy calls attention to the 2023 clerk's report.
 - a. Review of the report on pages 2–6 of the church conference packet, which includes a report of 2023 new members, members departing, those baptized and deaths along with the minutes from the 2022 church conferences.
 - b. Questions/Comments: none.
 - c. Motion to receive comes from Bob Coleman; 2nd by Gladys Kolenovsky.
 - d. Voting by voice.
 - e. The 2023 Clerks Report was approved.

II. Timothy introduces Jenny Wolff, chair of Committee on Committees, to present two recommendations from Committee on Committees.

- 1. Jenny calls attention to the 2024 committee recommendations on page 7 of the church conference packet.
 - a. Names in red are those new to committees.
 - b. New this year: youth reps were added for a one-year term on a few committees. This will help them learn more about church life.
 - c. The New Member Committee is changing to a Ministry Team.
 - d. Questions/Comments: none.
 - e. On behalf of the Committee on Committees, Jenny makes a motion to accept the recommendations.
 - f. 2nd by Susan Leonard.
 - g. Voting by voice.
 - h. The 2024 committees are approved.
- 2. Jenny makes a recommendation to re-elect Debby Burton as church clerk for 2024.
 - a. As per Wilshire's bylaws, the secretary or church clerk shall be nominated by the Committee on Committees and elected by the membership annually.
 - b. Explains the duties of the church clerk.
 - c. Questions/Comments: none.
 - d. 2nd by: Kathy Alverson.
 - e. Voting by voice.

- f. Debby Burton is reelected as church clerk for 2024.
- 3. Timothy expresses thanks to those who chaired a committee and presented a book: *A Rhythm of Prayer* by Sarah Bessey.

III. Recommendation from the Deacon Nominating Committee

- 1. Jill Granberry, chair of the Deacon Nominating Committee. presents the 2024 Deacon Nominating Committee report on page 9 of the church conference packet.
 - a. Jill thanks the committee comprised of herself, Everett Williams, Amy Anderson, Linda Garner, Susan Kimball, Tracy Sturdivant, Terry Wade, Andrew Warden and Jenny Wolff for their enthusiasm, time and prayerful commitment to nominate eight deacons to be ordained and eight deacons to return to active service.
 - b. The eight nominees for deacon ordination are: Lauren Ann Cove, Laurie Diffee, Mary Lu Hare, Rick Hibbs, Mary Morgan, Steven Murray, Rob Roden and Price Tinsley.
 - c. The eight rotating to active service are: Leigh Ann Brown, Fred Cullum (2 yr term), Bill Jernberg, Richard Luttrell, Sam Tinsley, Rhonda Walton, Megan Wilson and Alison Wingfield.
 - d. Questions/Comments: none.
 - e. On behalf of the Deacon Nominating Committee, Jill makes a motion to receive the report.
 - f. The motion comes from a standing committee; no 2nd is required.
 - g. Voting by voice.
 - h. The 2023 Deacon Nominating Committee report is approved.

IV. Bylaws Report

- 1. Timothy announces that in 2022 the deacons appointed a Bylaws Workgroup to amend our bylaws to bring them up to date with our current practices. Timothy calls on Gladys Kolenovsky, chair of the Bylaws Workgroup, to bring the report.
 - a. Gladys refers members to the presentation on pages 10–29 of the church conference packet with these explanations:
 - As members of the church, we have the power to set the rules of how we do business.
 - Over a year ago a work group of six volunteers was appointed. Paul Latham, Britt McClung, Max Tucker, Pat Cullum, Debbie Meripolski and Gladys Kolenovsky began to review bylaws.
 - The goal of the group was to align the bylaws with the current practices of the church.
 - Copies of the Proposed Bylaws Amendments were sent to the membership for review prior to this meeting.
 - The Deacons have reviewed the proposed bylaw amendments and voted to recommend them to the membership.

b. Questions and discussion:

- Bettye Collins questions why the wording on Article VI, Section 1(E) on page 24 needs to be deleted. The deleted language is "subject to the right of the membership to reverse or modify the action of the Personnel Committee upon a vote of a majority of the membership at a regular or special business meeting to approve a reversal or modification."
- Britt McClung, Bylaws Workgroup member, explains the wording is duplicated from another section.
- The goal of the Bylaws Workgroup was to make minimal changes without moving sections around, to only make adjustments and clean up the

- language to make it more clear according to what we do. The group did not change any practices.
- Sara Tinsley asks if the deletion of the language is made how will the membership have a voice and how will the congregation learn of terminations.
- Britt: This is how it was; we were not trying to reinvent wheels or change the wording. Tried to eliminate redundancy. The bylaws don't address the issue of making the membership aware of terminations.
- c. Max Tucker makes a motion to approve the bylaws amendments presented in the packet that have been recommended by the deacons.
- d. 2nd by Steven Cury.
- e. Further discussion on Article VI, Section 1E.
- f. Motion from the floor to add that language back that was crossed out.
- g. 2nd by Bob Coleman.
- h. Discussion on adding the language back.
- Vote on the amendment to restore the language that was deleted from Article VI, Section 1. E.
- Show of hands vote: Those in favor of restoring the deleted language in Article VI, Section 1, E, therefore in favor of the amendment. There were 109 in favor and 70 opposed.
- The amendment passes to restore the language.
- i. Other discussions on the seal of the church, the responsibilities of the Personnel Committee and membership. There were no amendments proposed in these sections.
- j. Voice vote on accepting the bylaws as now amended.
- k. Unanimous.
- I. Proposed Bylaws approved as presented with one amendment, to restore the original language of Article VI, Section 1(E).

V. State of the Church address by Timothy

- Thanks to Gladys for her leadership of the Deacons.
- Change is daunting for us.
- Who are we? A church for all people.
- Wants us to look into the dreams of our congregation.
- Tim had a question in the bulletin in March that asked the congregation what it needs. Connection and relationship were the top answers.
- Reviews all the places Wilshire provides opportunities for engagement: Sunday School, music ministry, missions and Pathways.
- Encourages us to leave space of how the Spirit is directing and leading us in ways we cannot see or imagine and be open to it.
- Brand story on our website: We strive to do things differently at Wilshire. We
 do the exciting and sometimes uncomfortable work of reconsidering our
 understanding of God and the way God works in the world. We also recognize
 that this reimaging is necessary communal nature. It's only in community that
 we are challenged to grow in our faith and instead of letting go of our Baptist
 heritage, we actually take Baptist convictions seriously.
- Explanation of the Unified Budget, surplus and giving of the year.
- Leading us to this number: \$3,925,000.

- 1. Presentation of the 2023 year-end financial report given on behalf of the Finance Committee by Lori Gooden, Director of Finance.
 - a. Thanks to a fantastic Finance Committee for their hard work.
 - b. Refers to page 30 of the packet for finance report.
 - Gave over \$1,000,000 in December (first time ever).
 - \$78,000 in prepaid tithes.
 - Thanks, church, for generosity.
 - c. On behalf of the Finance Committee, Lori asks that the financial report be accepted.
 - d. Questions/Comments: none.
 - e. Motion comes from a standing committee; no 2nd required.
 - f. Voting by voice.
 - g. Year-end report received.
- 2. The proposed 2024 Unified Budget presented by Lori Gooden, Director of Finance.
 - a. The 2024 proposed budget is on page 31.
 - Timothy shared what all is involved.
 - This represents the dreams of the staff.
 - b. Highlights of the proposed budget:
 - A structural change in the Personnel line item: all Personnel moved to a Personnel budget instead of in different ministry areas.
 - Additional funding added in the area of music for Ariel to be able to bring his
 dreams and visions to this program.
 - Increased missions budget for extra opportunities.
 - The support area has been increased due to repairs needed, higher utilities costs, higher taxes and insurance, which is the largest increase in the budget.
 - Some increases and some decreases in Personnel due to some benefits and life insurance rates changing.
 - Theological education budget moved to Pathways from the Unified Budget.
 This includes choral scholars and summer interns.
 - The George A. Mason Pathways Endowment was valued at \$9.5 million; over \$116,000 given to the Endowment in 2023
 - Since this is the last year of the Baugh Grant, we will start taking 80% of the built in capstone distribution, with an effective rate of 4%, while reinvesting 20% of the distribution.
 - c. Staff was intentional with keeping a flat budget.
 - d. On behalf of the Finance Committee, Lori submits the 2024 budget of \$3,925,000 to be approved.
 - e. Questions/Comments: none.
 - f. Motion comes from a standing committee; no 2nd required
 - g. Voting by voice.
 - h. 2024 budget is approved.
