Explore the heart of Old Québec's Upper and Lower Towns and examine the city's extensive fortification system with a local expert. Traverse down pedestrian streets and laneways of one of the oldest European settlements in North America. Lectures are brought to life with field trips encompassing both landmark sites and less heralded aspects of the city, opening doors to historic interiors that few visitors discover. Learn about the culture, traditions and history of Indigenous Peoples. Journey into the heart of the Huron-Wendat Nation with a field trip to the village of Wendake where you will visit a traditional longhouse and enjoy a memorable farewell dinner.

- Explore the Plains of Abraham, site of many clashes between the French and British Empires.
- Stroll along charming cobblestone streets, take in views of the St. Lawrence River, and admire the European-inspired architecture that defines both Upper and Lower Town in Québec City.
- Explore Wendake village and discover the rich history, culture, and artistic traditions of the Wendat people.
